Azizah Syiami Mutik is an ILCF student from Indonesia. Read more about her experience moving to France and learning French.

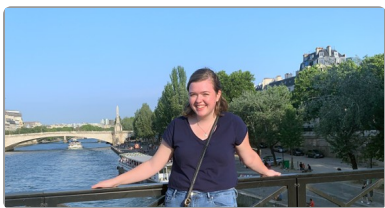
