

FRENCH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE COURSES

JANUARY TERM

Session description:

The most comprehensive course offered by ILCF, the intensive programme is open to anyone wishing to quickly acquire a solid command of French, both written and spoken, from level A1 to level C1.

This programme, comprising 20 hours of lessons per week, encourages students to participate actively not only in class but also in the cultural activities organised by ILCF.

Course duration

60 hours
20h/week

Levels

- A1 Discovery
- A2 Survival
- B1 Threshold
- B2 Advanced
- C1 Proficient

PROGRAMME OVERVIEW:

Description:

French language courses are designed to develop students' oral and written expression and comprehension skills. This aim of fostering autonomy in the use of French is achieved through the acquisition of grammar, vocabulary and the specific features of French culture. A variety of language-based activities are offered to students and are organised using teaching methods, workbooks and authentic materials: newspapers, adverts, comic strips, literary texts, videos, etc. The lessons encourage active student participation.

Target audience:

This programme is aimed at all international adult students, regardless of their level of French, who wish to acquire and develop their spoken and written French skills.

Placement test:

Before the start of each term, a compulsory online placement test assessing written and oral skills is held to place students into groups of similar ability.

Level:

ILCF places students in groups (averaging 18 students) according to their level:

- A1 Discovery > A2 Survival > B1 Threshold > B2 Advanced > C1 Proficient

Course details:

- 3 weeks: 60 hours – 20 hours per week
- Option to take several consecutive courses
- Levels A1.1 to C1: 60 hours of French language lessons
- The 20-hour courses take place on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays from 10.00 to 13.00 and on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 14.00 to 17.00.

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Course qualifications:

The course leads to a French language certificate.

Assessment method: continuous assessment + final examination

Credits: 6 ECTS credits
