

FRENCH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE COURSES

FROM 15 HOURS PER WEEK

Session description:

The most complete course offered by ILCF, the intensive programme is open to anyone wishing to quickly acquire a solid command of French, both written and spoken, from level A1 to level C1.

This programme, comprising 15 hours of lessons per week, encourages students to participate actively not only in class but also in the cultural activities organised by the ILCF.

PROGRAMME OVERVIEW:

Description:

French language courses are designed to develop students' oral and written expression and comprehension skills. This aim of fostering autonomy in the use of French is achieved through the acquisition of grammar, vocabulary and the specific features of French culture. A variety of language-based activities are offered to students and are organised using teaching methods, workbooks and authentic materials: newspapers, adverts, comic strips, literary texts, videos, etc. The lessons encourage active student participation.

Target audience:

This programme is aimed at all international adult students, regardless of their level of French, who wish to acquire and develop their spoken and written French skills.

Placement test:

Before the start of each term, a compulsory online placement test assessing written and oral skills is held to place students into groups of similar ability.

Level:

ILCF places students in groups (averaging 18 students) according to their level:

- A1 Discovery > A2 Survival > B1 Threshold > B2 Advanced > C1 Proficient

Course details:

- 1 semester: from 210 hours
- Option to take several consecutive courses
- The intensive programme comprises 15 hours of tuition per week.
- Levels A1 to B2: a minimum of 210 hours of French language lessons.
- Level C1: a minimum of 210 hours of French language and civilisation lessons
- Lessons take place on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays from 10.00 to 13.00.
- From level A2 onwards, the Tuesday lesson is online

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Course qualifications:

The course leads to a French language certificate and the DUEF language diploma, accredited by the ADCUEFE (Association of University Centres for French as a Foreign Language).

Le DUEF (University Diploma in French Studies), corresponding to the level achieved during the semester, is awarded at the end of the course, following successful completion of the assessments and provided that, from level B1.1 onwards, a course in French civilisation has been taken.

Assessment method: continuous assessment + final examination

Credits: 20 ECTS credits + any specialist or civilisation courses taken

HOW DO YOU CHOOSE A COURSE?

You can choose to take one or two specialised courses, depending on your level, including spoken French, written French, phonetics and French civilisation.
Course load: 42 hours per week per course.
