# **ACADEMIC INFORMATION**

#### **Placement Test**

### Assessment of your level is mandatory.

Your French level is determined by an online test taken before your arrival in France (your login and password will be sent to you by e-mail).

#### Schedule

**Semester sessions:** your timetable depends on the number of hours of FLE classes and specialty courses you have chosen.

**Monthly sessions:** the timetable is the same for all students.

#### **F**xams

For French language courses, exams are based on continuous assessment and a final exam at the end of the session based on the four skills: oral and written expression.

#### Certificate

At the end of each session, you will receive a "Certificate of Study in French as a Foreign Language", listing the courses and number of hours taken, the level acquired or currently in progress, and the ECTS credits obtained.

# **European Credit Transfer System (ECTS)**

The ECTS are attributed if your average in the course is equal or higher than 10 out of 20.

10 hours of courses are equivalent to 1 credit ECTS.

#### Certified examination center

ILCF is a certified examination center for the DCL FLE (Diplôme de Compétence en Langue). This is a state diploma for professional purposes, issued by the French Ministry of Education.

# PRACTICAL INFORMATION

### **Before registering**

For stays of more than three months, if you need a student visa, or if you are a beginner, you must register for either 15, 18 or 21 hours per week.

For any question related to visas, please consult the Campus France office, the French Consulate or the French Embassy in your country.

We advise you to register as early as possible, in order to take into account the time it takes to obtain a visa (between one and three months).
